Eric Seib gave maintenance report, inmates doing a great job on Livestock Market, mowing park. Well #3 pumped failed, Griner to fix March 6, pump and motor are under a 1-year warranty. Trent and Zack worked weekend on Well. We are monitoring 3 water meters with high usage, Core and Main to contact office. Two Flush valves to be installed this week. US Tank to perform clean out on Calfee Street tank, clean out scheduled for March 14th. Cast iron wash out to be Summer project, not enough valves to isolate a line for ice pigging, flushing contract until ice pigging can work. Owens suggested to discuss at next Wednesday workshop.
